



VACANCY FOR THE OFFICE OF PARISH COUNCILLOR

Have you thought of becoming a Parish Councillor?

There is a vacancy on Wootton Parish Council for a Councillor to serve for four years until May 2023. The vacancy will be filled by co-optation at the next Parish Council meeting on 3rd September 2019.

If you are: Aged 18 or over, on the electoral roll, citizen of UK, Commonwealth, EU or Ireland and resident in or within 3 miles of the parish or own land or work in the parish (for at least 12 months) you are eligible to be co-opted.

If you are:

- Able to attend regular evening meetings; the Parish Council Meetings are usually held on the first Tuesday of each month at 7:30pm in the Wootton and Dry Sandford Community Centre.
- Interested in local issues, preferably not just a single issue

And have:

- An understanding and willingness to represent the views of the whole community
- An interest in being an effective councillor

You could be just what the Parish Council is looking for.

Please note the post of Parish Councillor is voluntary, with expenses paid only when necessary.
